COMMERCIAL OFFER

The Association of Sea Fishermen – Producers Organization is a Partner of the FindFISH Project, implemented in a Consortium along with the Institute of Oceanology of the Polish Academy of Sciences (PAN) and the Maritime Institute in Gdańsk. The Project's objective was to create the FindFISH Knowledge Transfer Platform based on in situ research, environmental data, quantitative and qualitative fishing data, and numerical modeling of hydrodynamic, physicochemical, and biological parameters of the Gulf of Gdańsk.

The FindFISH Platform was developed based on knowledge transfer between two user groups: scientists and fishermen. It is an online database and forecast system about the marine environment of the Gulf of Gdańsk and its living resources, enabling users to obtain current forecasts about the marine environment conditions of the Gulf of Gdańsk and the locations of commercially fished species.

We offer access to the FindFISH Platform to all interested parties.

To gain access to the FindFISH Platform (to the model data), one must register and then make a payment via bank transfer to the account of the Association of Sea Fishermen - Producers Organization, Portowa 10 Street, Władysławowo, as indicated on the FindFISH Platform website with the transfer title: access to FF platform / first and last name / fishing mark. The price for access to FindFISH for 30 days is 50,00 PLN (payment in EURO is possible after conversion according to the average exchange rate of the foreign currency announced by the NBP on the last working day preceding the invoice date). After the payment is credited to the account, access to the Platform is possible after the administrator adds the login and access password. The user receives an access password that is valid for 30 days from the date of access. This allows the user to access current forecasts during the validity period of the password. On the FindFISH Platform service, forecasts are periodically updated (4 times a day), so the data obtained with a password of a specified validity time becomes outdated over time. If the user wants to continue using the service after this period to have access to current data, they must purchase an extension of the service validity (access for another period).
